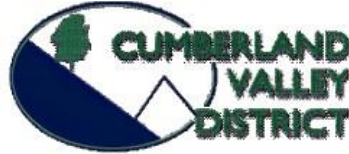


*Would you like to improve the health of your community?*

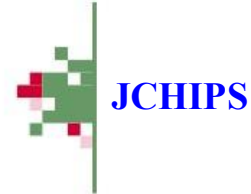
JCHIPS meets every 3rd Tuesday of the month, at Noon, currently via Zoom.

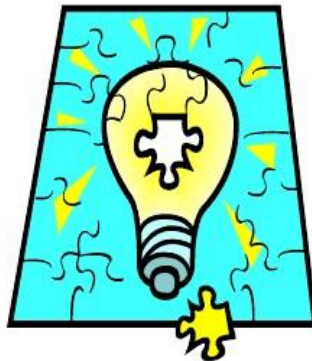
The overall goal of JCHIPS is to work together to improve the health of our community.

## An Active Health Council

JCHIPS is an active health council.

Activities of the council include:

- Community Health Assessment
- Annual Community Health Fair
- Health News and Updates
- Purchase of carbon monoxide and smoke detectors that were distributed to the community
- Purchase of infant car seats and booster seats for car seat safety and installation events
- Bike helmets were purchased and used in elementary safety classes
- Increasing opportunities of physical activity

- Received a Dental Sealant Grant that will provide sealants to school children
- Received a Champions Grant through the KY ASAP program to promote substance abuse and violence prevention
- Received a grant from the American Heart Association to purchase four AED's (Automated External Defibrillators) to place at each of the county fire departments
- Sponsors activities for smoking prevention and cessation programs in schools and in the community
- Conducted a School Health Index survey in the schools
- Students Taking Charge
- Increasing access to Healthy Foods;
- Promotion of Local Farmers Market
- Encourage the development of Smoke-Free Policy, 24/7 Tobacco Free Schools
